Subject: Agenda Item #4.A1 Administrative and Committee Reports – 2/2/12 Board Meeting District / CAL FIRE Manager Report for December and Annual 2011

EMERGENCY ACTIVITY

1. Station 15-South Bay responded to 84 calls in December with two Simultaneous Calls (Back to Back). Two of the Simultaneous Calls required Advanced Life Support. Of these 84 incidents, 60 were Medical calls with 32 requiring Advanced Life Support provided by Paramedics. Four incidents were reported as a Traffic Collision; four incidents were reported as Fires, nine as Public Service Assists, and two as Emergency.
2. Company 15 was called to cover the station or respond to emergencies in the month of December a total of 5 times.
3. Station 15-South Bay responded to 1206 calls in 2011 with 63 Simultaneous Calls (Back to Back). 33 of the Simultaneous Calls required Advanced Life Support. Of these 1206 incidents, 787 were Medical calls with 435 requiring Advanced Life Support provided by Paramedics. 29 incidents were reported as a Traffic Collision; 71 incidents were reported as Fires, 220 as Public Service Assists, and 38 as Emergency.
4. Company 15 was called to cover the station or respond to emergencies in 2011 a total of 159 times.

SPECIAL PROJECTS

5. The Los Osos Fire Safe Focus Group met on December 2, 2011 to discuss the status and progress of current and past projects. The group also discussed future projects and applications for hazard abatement needs in and around the community of Los Osos. The Focus Group also looked at options for maintaining current projects in progress, as this is a stipulation of funding from the Fire Safe Council. Lastly, the group toured the project on the Broderson Property to evaluate the progress.

COMMUNITY EVENTS

6. Station 15-South Bay participated in Operation Santa Claus 2011 in cooperation with the CAL FIRE Firefighters Benevolence Association. This year 200+ toys were donated to Operation Santa Claus at Station 15 by the community of Los Osos. Donated toys were given to the San Luis Obispo County Child Welfare Office for children in foster homes or the county shelter for the holiday season and birthdays throughout the year. A special note of appreciation to the Los Osos branch of Edward Jones Investments for hosting a donation barrel in their office and supporting the Operation Santa Claus program.

7. On December 10, 2011, Station 15-South Bay attended the Los Osos Holiday Parade. Medic Engine 15, Medic Rescue 15, Engine 215, Utility 15, and Boat 15 all represented Station 15-South Bay with their family and friends, including Smokey Bear and Sparky the Fire Safety Dog.
