EMERGENCY ACTIVITY

1. Station 15-South Bay responded to 99 calls in November with 5 Simultaneous Calls (Back to Back). Three of the Simultaneous Calls required Advanced Life Support. Of these 99 incidents, 66 were Medical calls with 25 requiring Advanced Life Support provided by Paramedics. Three incidents were reported as Fires, 24 Public Services Assists, and five as Emergency.
2. Company 15 was called to cover the station or respond to emergencies in the month of November a total of 10 times.

TRAINING

3. Reserve Firefighters Nate Hamm and Mark Bailey, as well as Executive Assistant Amy Jones, attended ICS I-300 November 9-11, 2009. This course National Incident Management Systems - Intermediate Incident Command Systems and teaches the transition from initial response to larger, extended response incidents emphasizing incident command, management and Incident Command Systems positions.
4. Reserve Firefighters Ian Goodyear and Nick Bishop attended the Pump Operations course November 10, 12, 14, 2009. This course, in conjunction with State Fire Marshall Emergency Vehicle Operations and approximately 20 hours of one-on-one driver training allows reserve firefighters to drive LOCSD fire equipment to and from emergencies.
5. Reserve Firefighter Stanley Craig attended the State Fire Marshall's Low Angle Rope Rescue Operations class where he learned basic to advanced operational techniques for cliff rescues.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

6. Station 15-South Bay staff gave daily station tours from November 2 to November 5, 2009 to the Los Osos Parent Participation Program preschool. Four separate classes consisting of approximately 110 children and parents toured the station during this week. Station 15 also gave a station tour to 21 2-5 year olds from the Sunny Side State Preschool. During all of the tours the on-duty personnel taught the children about fire engines and apparatus, familiarized the children with a Firefighter's appearance

when dressed in protective gear, and practiced fire safety lessons such as “Get Down, Stay Low, Get Out”. The children given Fire Safety Bags consisting of materials for fire education aimed at preschoolers when they left.
