District /CAL FIRE Chief Report for January 2019**

EMERGENCY ACTIVITY

1. Station 15 - South Bay responded to 142 calls between December 24-January 23, including 94 Medical Aids and 4 Traffic Collisions; 2 incidents were reported as Fire, 10 as Hazardous; 21 as Public Service Assists; and 10 false alarms.

Company 15 was called to cover the station or respond to emergencies 7 times between December 24th-January 23rd.

ADMINISTRATION

2. The four prospective Station 15 – South Bay Reserve Firefighter candidates continued completing steps needed to become employees of the LOCSO. In January, all of the candidates successfully completed a medical evaluation and were cleared by a doctor to be Fit Tested for Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus as required by OSHA as well as to work for the LOCSO. Each candidate was issued a department uniform and personal protective equipment (turn-outs).
3. On January 20, 2019, Reserve Firefighter Tyler Loudermilk resigned to pursue a full-time EMT Career and a degree in Emergency Management. He proudly served the community of Los Osos for 4 years. We hope happiness and health follow Tyler, his wife and their 3 children in their next endeavors.

ADMINISTRATION

4. As the top candidate in the State of California for open Firefighter II positions, Reserve Firefighter Chris Podesta will have his choice regarding what city he wants to work in. With this knowledge, he resigned on January 09, 2019 to be closer to his family in the valley. We wish Chris continued success.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS/PROJECTS

5. On January 19, 2019, Station 15 – South Bay celebrated the successes of 2018 at The Clubhouse Grill at Sea Pines Golf Resort. Retired Reserve Firefighter John Robson was recognized by the Department for his 13 years of service to the community of Los Osos. CAL FIRE Firefighter Jim Green received the CAL FIRE Firefighter of the Year award for the second year in a row for his excellent service to the community of Los Osos and to his fellow peers.
6. Local Citizen Tom Wright continued his work toward building a public library box that will be placed in front of Station 15. Everyone here at the station is excited to see the final piece of art he has created and know the community will benefit from having this fun and educational feature at the Station.

7. On January 29, 2019, Station 15 – South Bay Reserve Firefighters Connor Smith and Denver Chavez provided Extinguisher Flash Pan training to the Estero Bay C.E.R.T. Team.

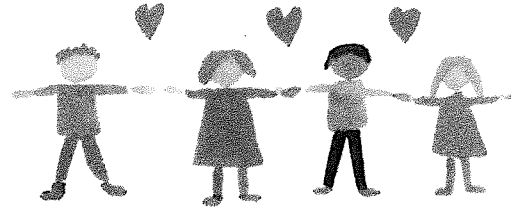
