SPECIAL PROGRAMS/PROJECTS

1. Station 15 –South Bay has been partaking in annual Continuing Professional Training and has received training on Vehicle Stabilization, Rope Rescue, Diablo Canyon Response, Lithium-Ion Battery Fire Response, Hazardous Materials Response, and Emergency Medical Response.
2. Station 15 – South Bay participated in multi company training focusing on forcible entry.
3. Station 15 – South Bay hosted a station tour for Christ Classical School.

Incidents

1. Station 15 – South Bay was impacted by storm activity, in addition to normal emergency responses a high number of storm related incidents were mitigated i.e., trees and powerlines down.
2. Station 15 – During the heavy rains Station 15 personnel along with Water District personnel closely monitored the areas retention basins.

2023

1. South Bay with City Gate Associates performed a Standards of Cover Study.
2. South Bay with Omni Design performed an assessment of Fire Station 15.
3. South Bay Reserve Firefighters started the year with 17 personnel, separated 10, have 1 out on long-term injury, and hired 7 new candidates.
4. South Bay Reserve Firefighters covered 599 of 856 shifts needed for 4-person staffing.
5. South Bay contracted with Fire Catt to test 8,410' of fire hose and upgraded our inventory tracking system to keep better records and perform more accurate testing of the fire hose.
6. South Bay conducted 29 public education events.
7. South Bay completed 1147 hours of in-service training.
8. South Bay responded to 1434 total calls for service.

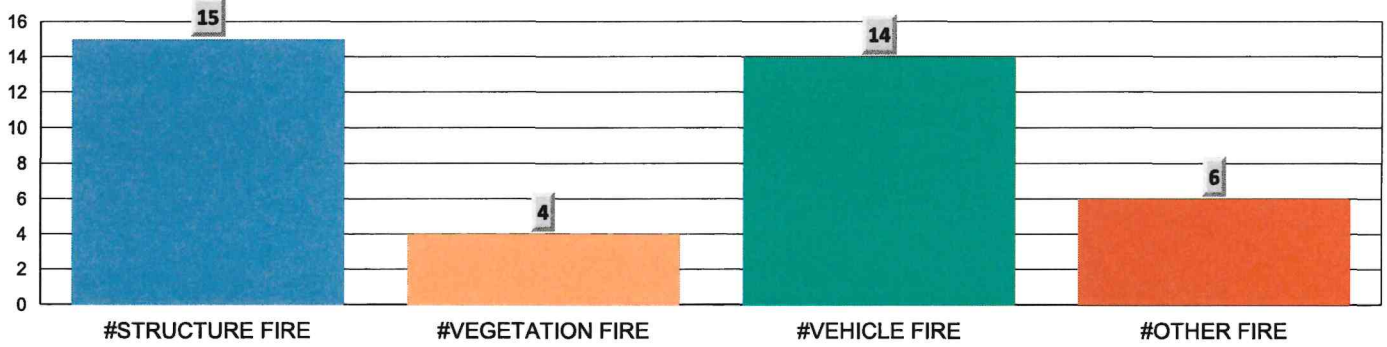

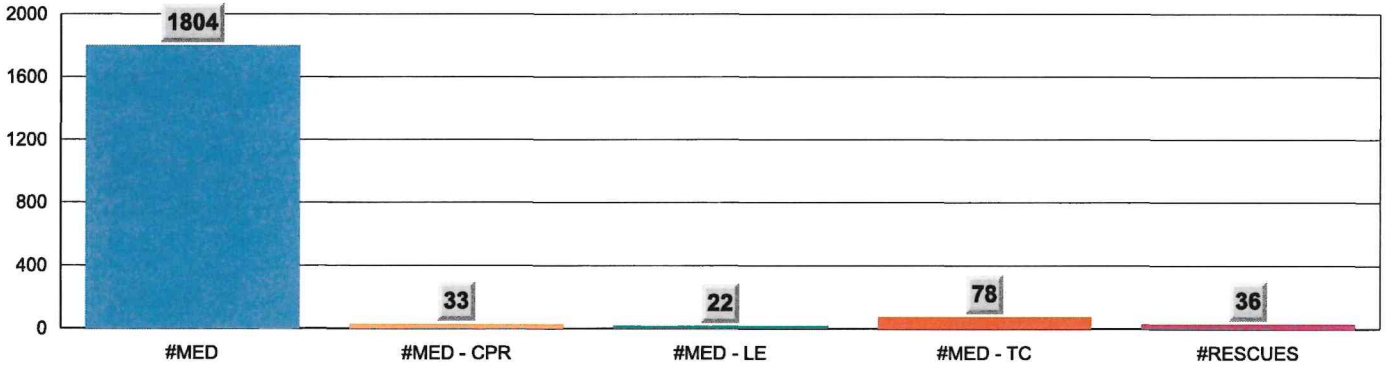

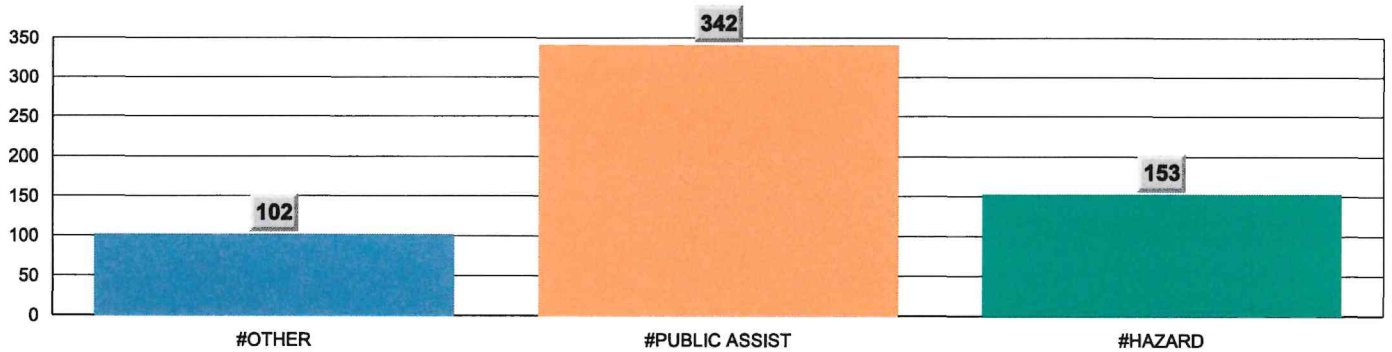
FIRE RESPONSES BY TYPE



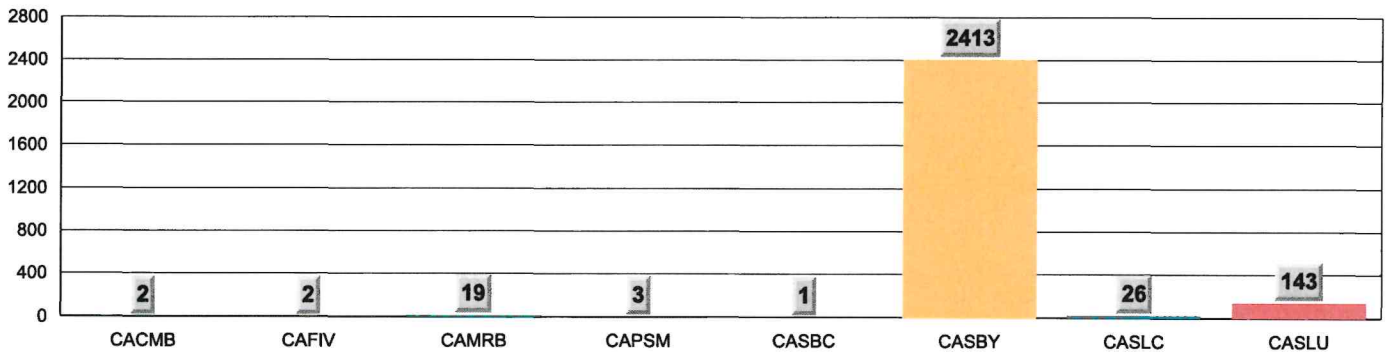
MEDICAL RESPONSES BY TYPE



MISCELLANEOUS RESPONSES BY TYPE



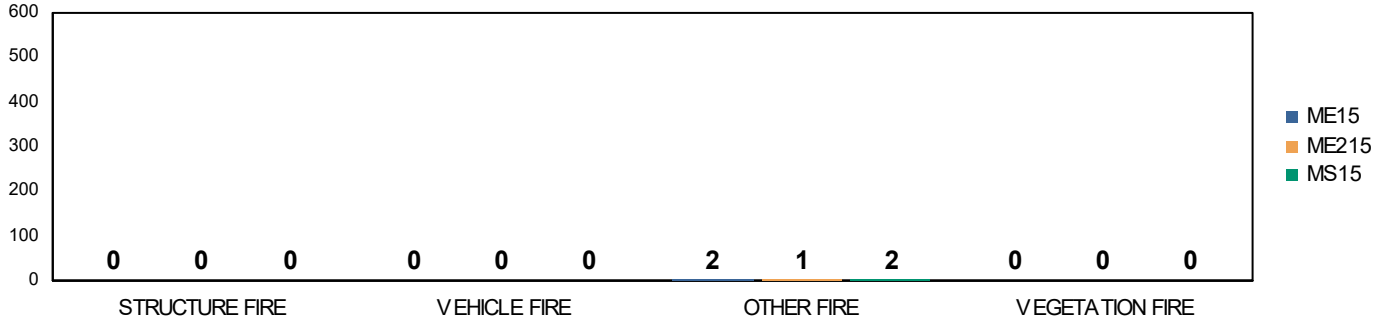
RESPONSES BY JURISDICTION



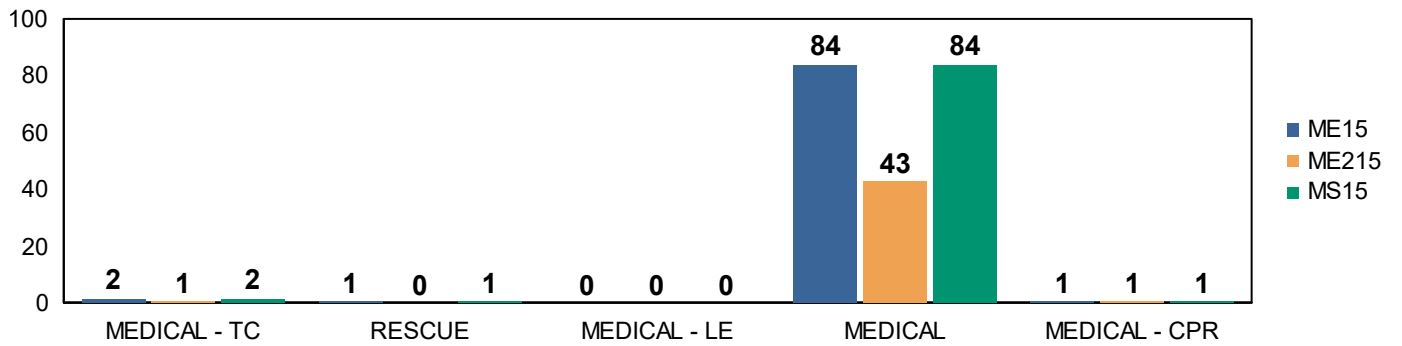

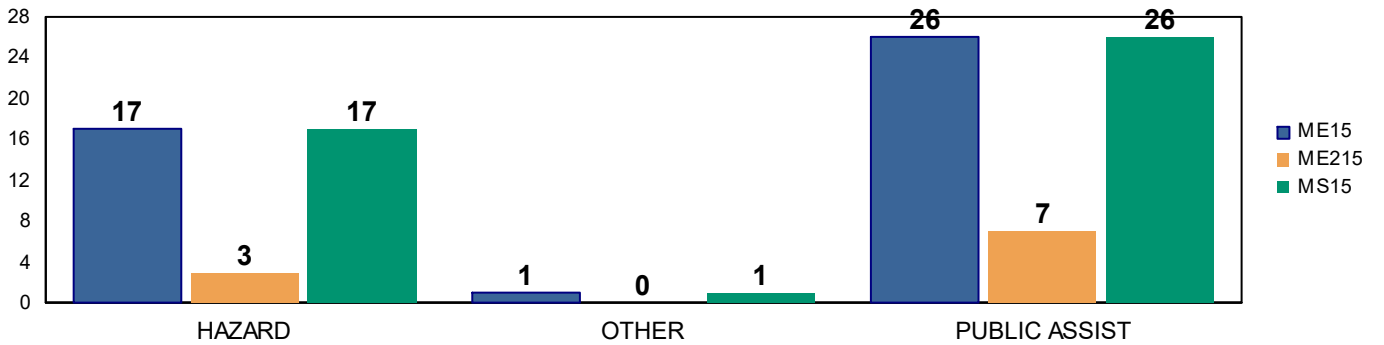
FIRES BY TYPE



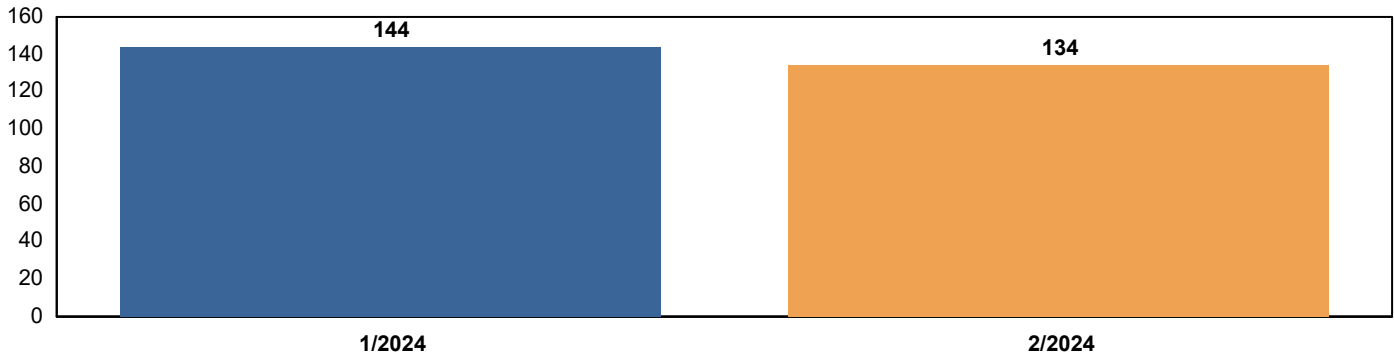
MEDICAL BY TYPE



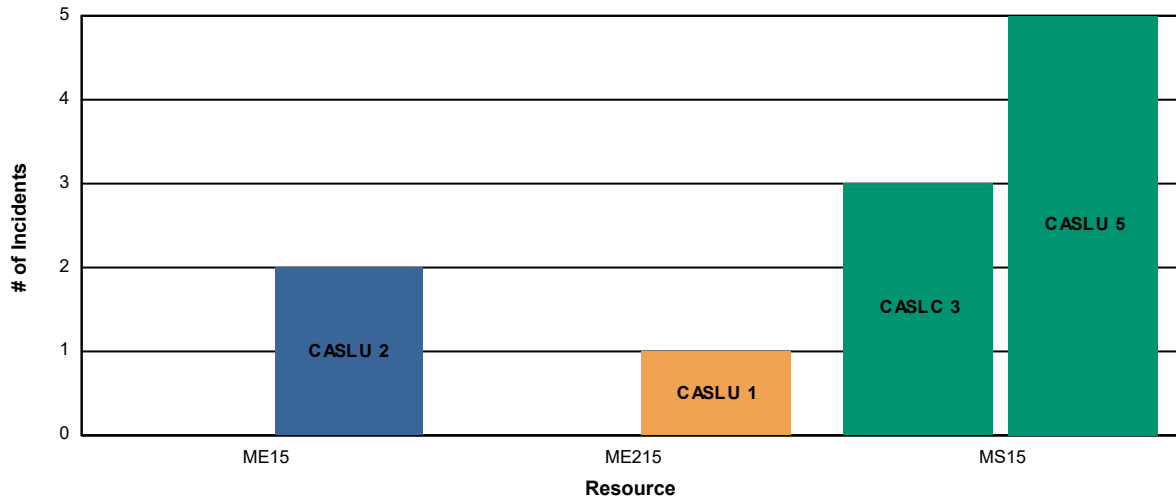

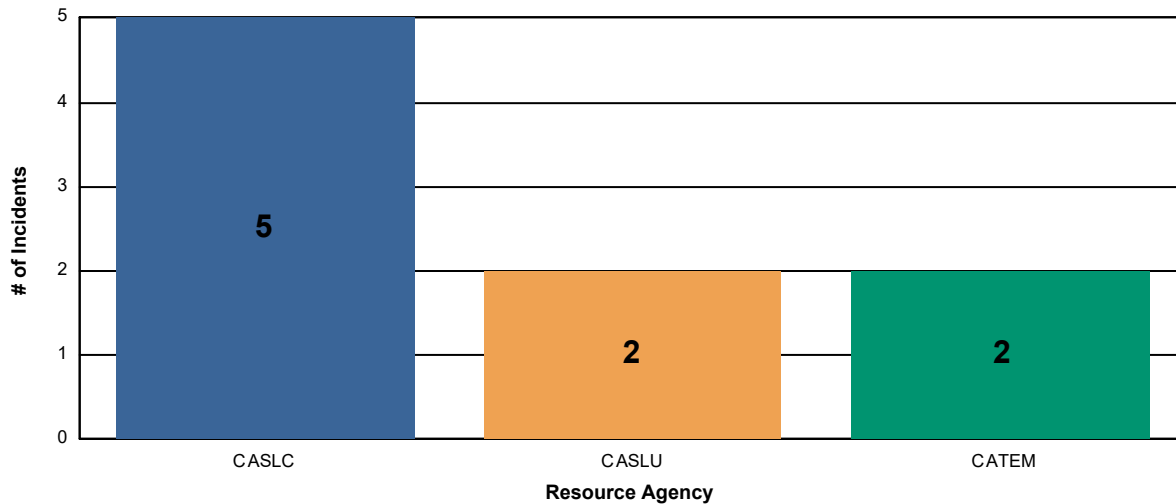
Station 15 Incidents per Month
