District /CAL FIRE Chief Report for June - August 2026

EMERGENCY ACTIVITY

1. Station 15 - South Bay responded to 300 calls from June 1 – August 11, 2026. This included 243 Medical Aids– with 17 Vehicle Accidents, 2 Surf Rescues and 1 Cliff Rescue, 37 Public Assists, 7 Hazardous Conditions, 1 Fire – Debris, 2 Fire – Residential, and 10 Fire - False Alarm.

ADMINISTRATION

2. Throughout May & June, Station 15 – South Bay advertised on multiple platforms regarding new applicants for our Reserve Company. A Physical Ability Test (PAT) and oral interviews were held on July 18, 2026. Seven candidates were selected to continue in the hiring process. The next step is a medical exam by a physician and pending medical clearance, applicants will then be provided with the required training prior to being eligible to work shifts or respond to call backs at Station 15 - South Bay.
3. Station 15 – South Bay is always accepting Reserve Firefighter applications. Applications may be picked up and turned in at 2315 Bayview Heights Drive Los Osos, CA 93402. The application packet may also be found online at <https://www.losososcscsd.org/hiring-reserve-firefighters>.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS/PROJECTS

4. The final deadline for fire hazard abatement was July 1, 2026. Upon final inspection, 39 lots were not in compliance. The LOCSO has scheduled a public hearing on August 20, 2026, to order abatement of public nuisance per Ordinance 2025-02.
5. In collaboration with the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) and San Luis Obispo County Air Pollution Control District, CAL FIRE's San Luis Obispo Unit will conduct prescribed burns as part of an ongoing habitat restoration project at Morro Dunes Ecological Reserve. Operations began on July 14, 2026, and due to the amount of fuel being removed, this will be an ongoing project with several burn days when weather permits.
6. Fire Apparatus Engineer – Paramedic, Breece Ehrenborg, participated as a mentor at Camp Cinder from June 29 - July 2. Camp Cinder is an immersive fire camp for girls ages 15-17, where participants have the opportunity to learn from female fire service mentors. The mission of Camp Cinder is to provide young women a safe, dynamic, interactive and challenging environment to gain strength, knowledge, and confidence in their ability to excel in the profession of firefighting and beyond.
7. From June 2 – June 4, 2026, several Company 15 Reserve Firefighters had the opportunity to participate in the Valley Acquired Structure Training Burn alongside CALFIRE personnel and other surrounding agencies. Training goals included fireground communication, tactical size-ups, 360-degree walkarounds, task-oriented firefighting, and Rapid Intervention/firefighter survival under live-fire conditions.

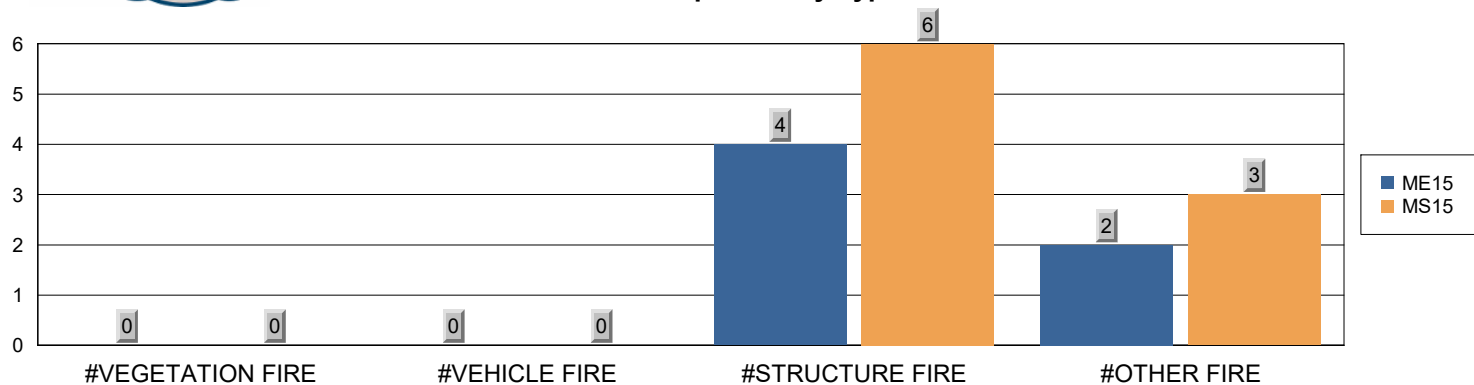




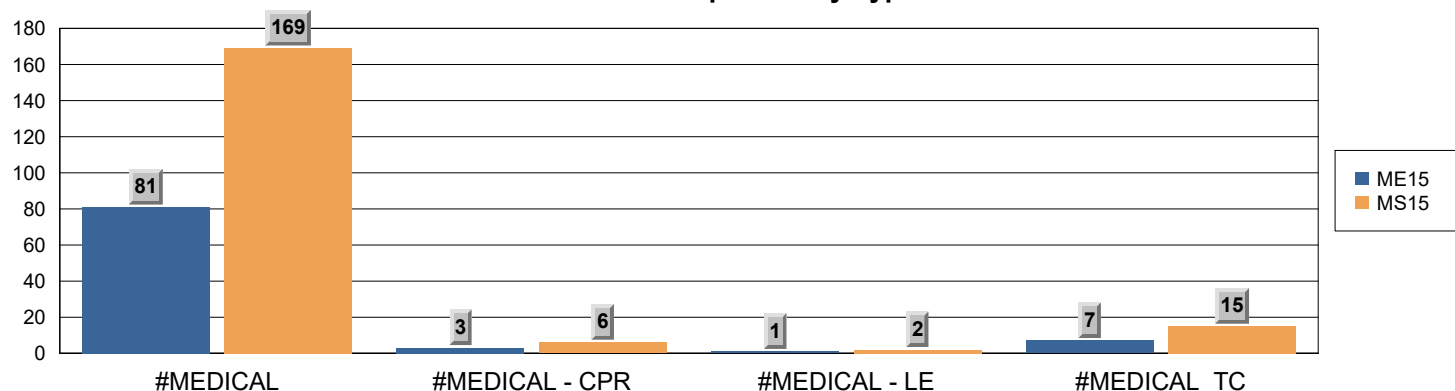

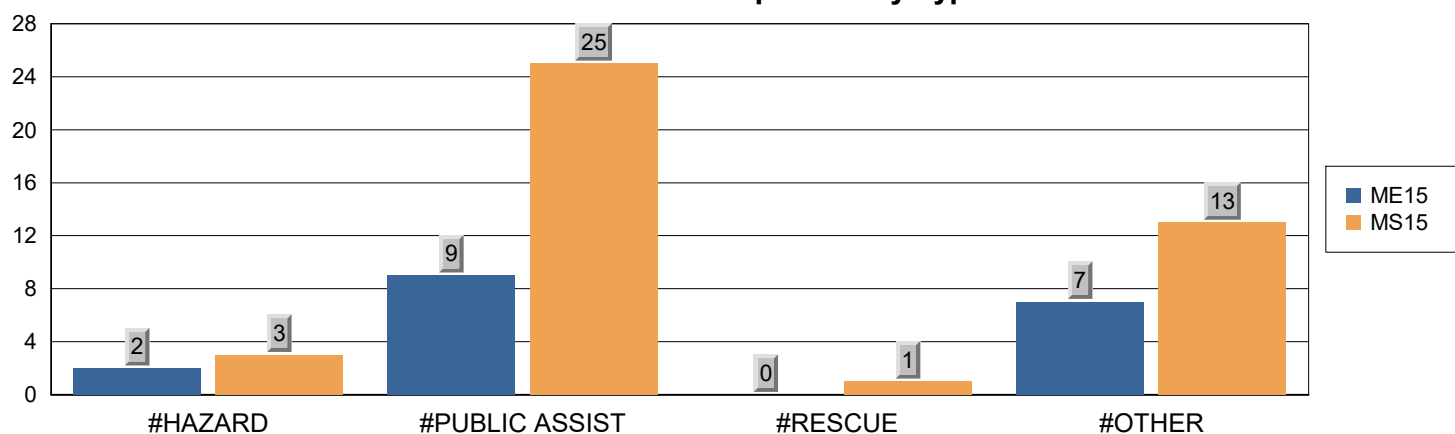
Fire Responses by Type

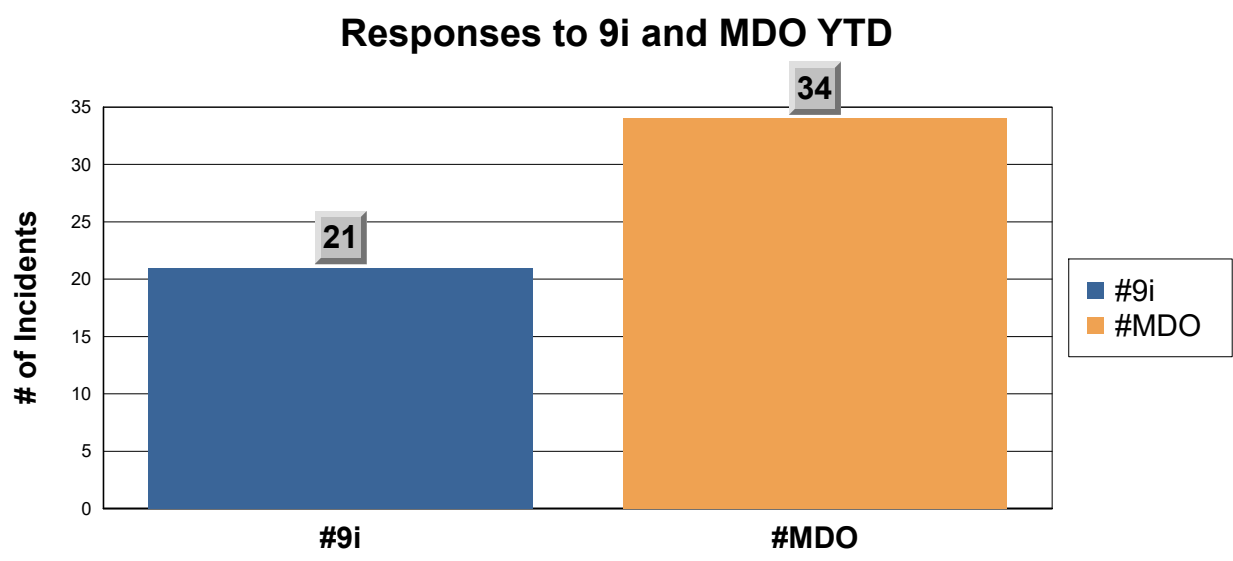
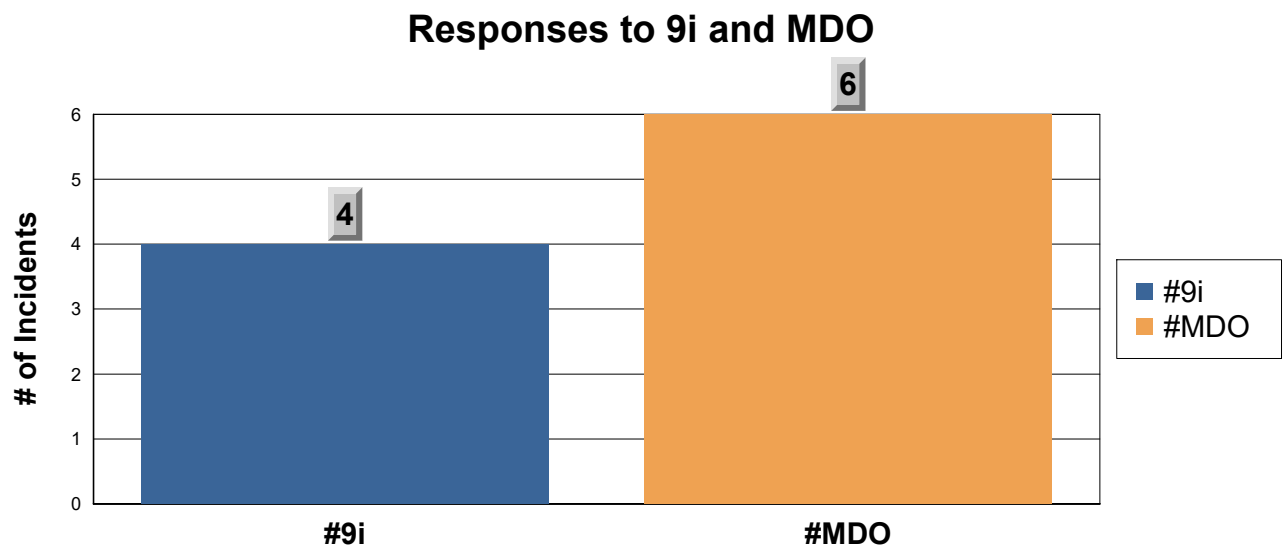


Medical Responses by Type

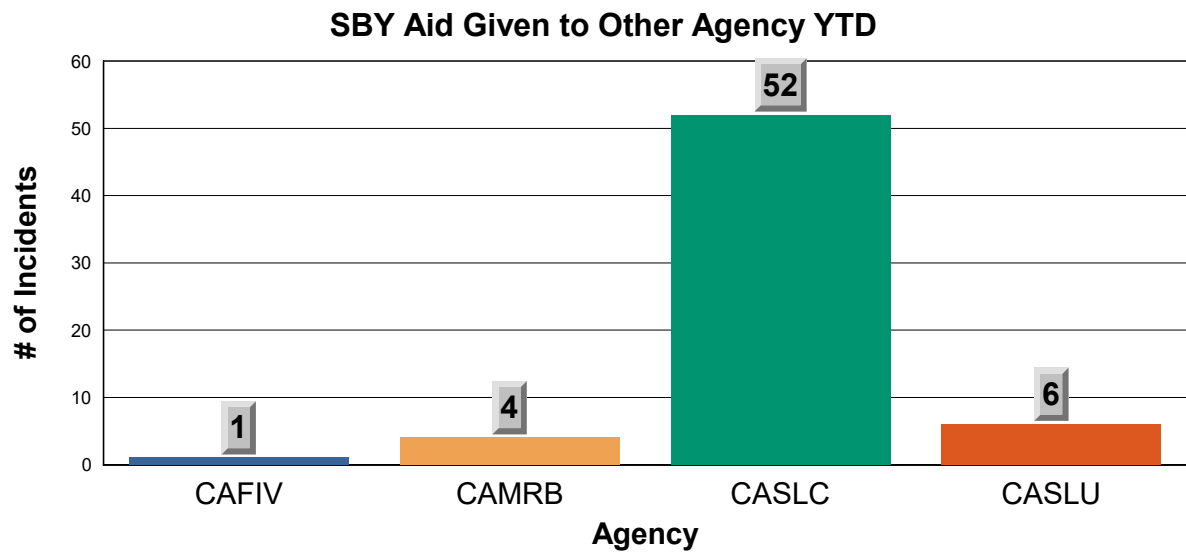
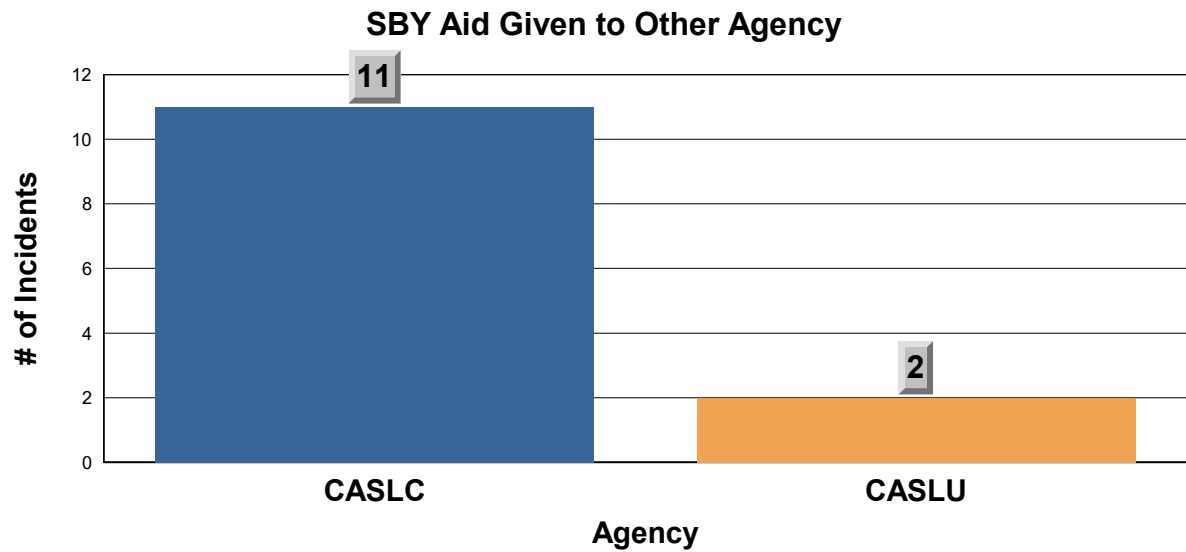


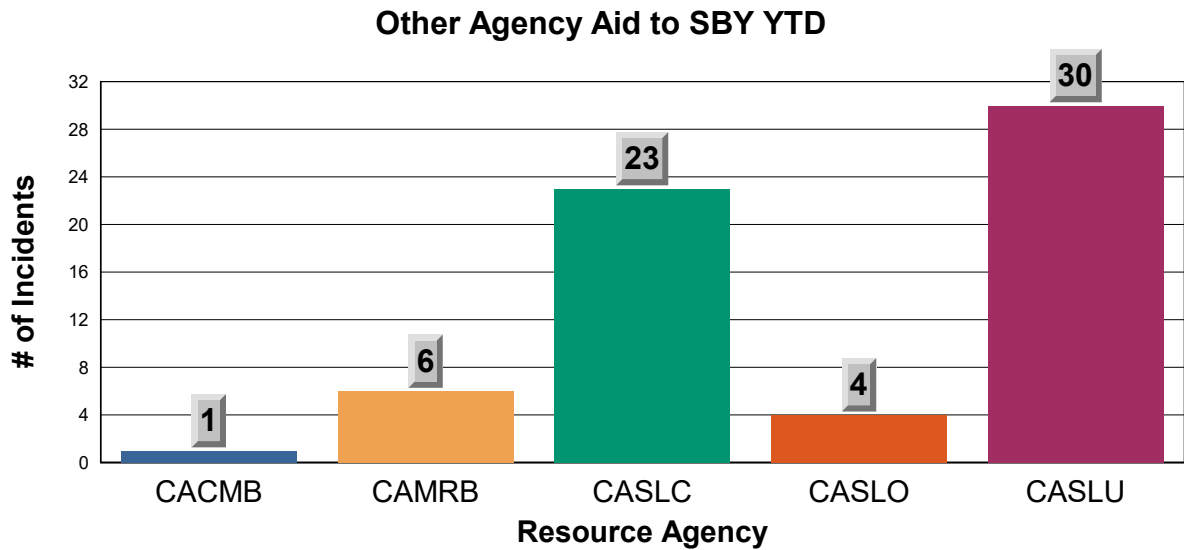
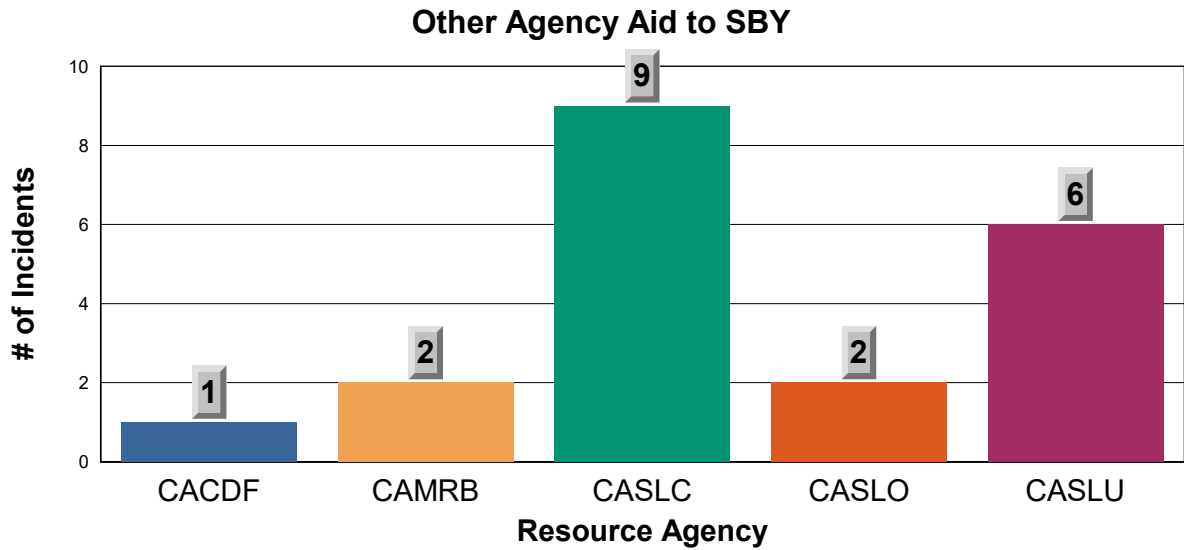

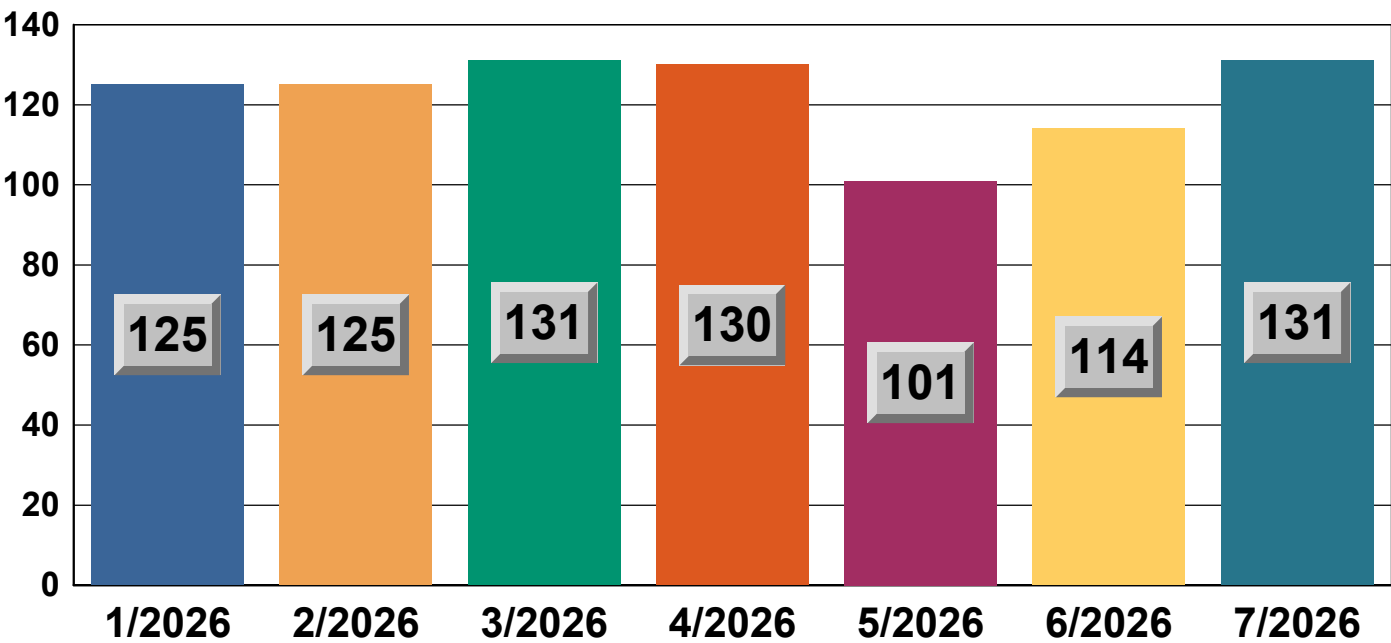
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Station 15 Incidents per Month



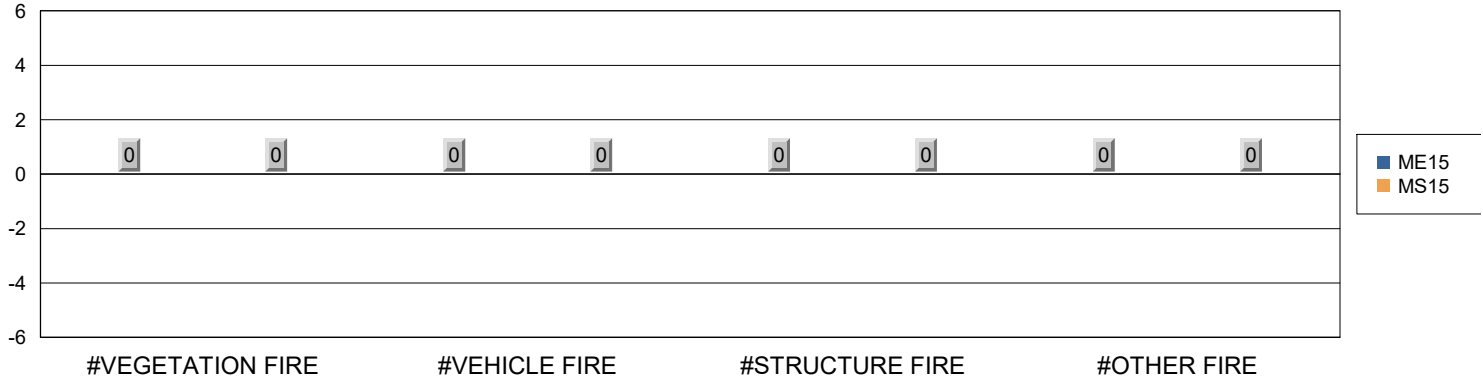
