District /CAL FIRE Chief Report for May 2019**

**EMERGENCY ACTIVITY**

1. Station 15 - South Bay responded to 122 calls between April 21<sup>st</sup> – May 24<sup>th</sup>, including 82 Medical Aids, and 11 Traffic Collisions, 4 incidents were reported as Fire, 1 as Hazardous, 16 as Public Service Assists, and 7 as false alarms.

Company 15 was called to cover the station or respond to emergencies 5 times between April 21<sup>st</sup> – May 24<sup>th</sup>.

**ADMINISTRATION**

2. During the month of April, Station 15 – South Bay Firefighters continued inspecting local business for their yearly safety inspections. This is an ongoing project they will continue throughout the year.
3. Station 15 – South Bay staff continued the budget preparation process through the month of May. Time was spent ensuring that the current budget was accurate and valid to provide a solid foundation for the next fiscal year budget.
4. May 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup>, Station 15 – South Bay's Office Assistant Young attended the Annual California Fire Chief's Association Administrative Fire Services Section (AFSS) in Paso Robles, CA. AFSS serves as a resource network for fire professionals to increase proficiency, enhance professional status, promotes educational opportunities and encourages leadership development.

## **SPECIAL PROGRAMS/PROJECTS**

5. During the month of May, Fire Apparatus Engineer Jim Green finished an American Flag project composed of repurposed fire hoses. This flag has been hung in our Engine Bay and will be enjoyed for many years to come.
6. On May 3<sup>rd</sup> Station 15 – South Bay visited Baywood Elementary School and met with approximately 53 kindergarteners. Firefighters read to them, spoke about basic fire safety tips, and sent them home with stickers and other trinkets.
7. On Saturday, May 18<sup>th</sup>, Station 15 – South Bay hosted the Estero Bay Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) meeting in our onsite training room.
8. On May 21<sup>st</sup>, Station 15 – South Bay visited a local Girl Scout Troop meeting of approximately 15 children in kindergarten and 1<sup>st</sup> grade. They read a short book, gave a Fire Engine tour, and focused on the group's current lesson, which was respecting authority.
9. On May 27<sup>th</sup>, 2019 Station 15 – South Bay personnel attended the annual Memorial Day Service at Los Osos Valley Mortuary.
10. On May 23<sup>rd</sup>, Station 15 – South Bay hosted the Emergency Services Advisory Committee meeting at the station. Along with general topics, a tour of Station 15 – South Bay was given to all attendees focusing on prior and future improvements of Station 15.

## **TRAINING**

11. During the month of May, Fire Apparatus Engineer Daniel Hauer completed a Swift Water Rescue course and an Auto Extrication course.
12. On May 18<sup>th</sup> Captain John Pearl completed a Boat 33/34 Crewmember course. This course reviewed basic knowledge to help when assisting boat operators in water rescues.
13. On May 22<sup>nd</sup>, Captain John Pearl, Captain Danny Ciecek, and Fire Apparatus Engineer Teddy Borja attended the Trauma Grand Rounds course at the Sierra Vista Auditorium.
14. On May 23<sup>rd</sup>, Fire Apparatus Engineer Teddy Borja attended a Spinal Motion Restriction course held in Arroyo Grande. This was a requirement for his paramedic training.

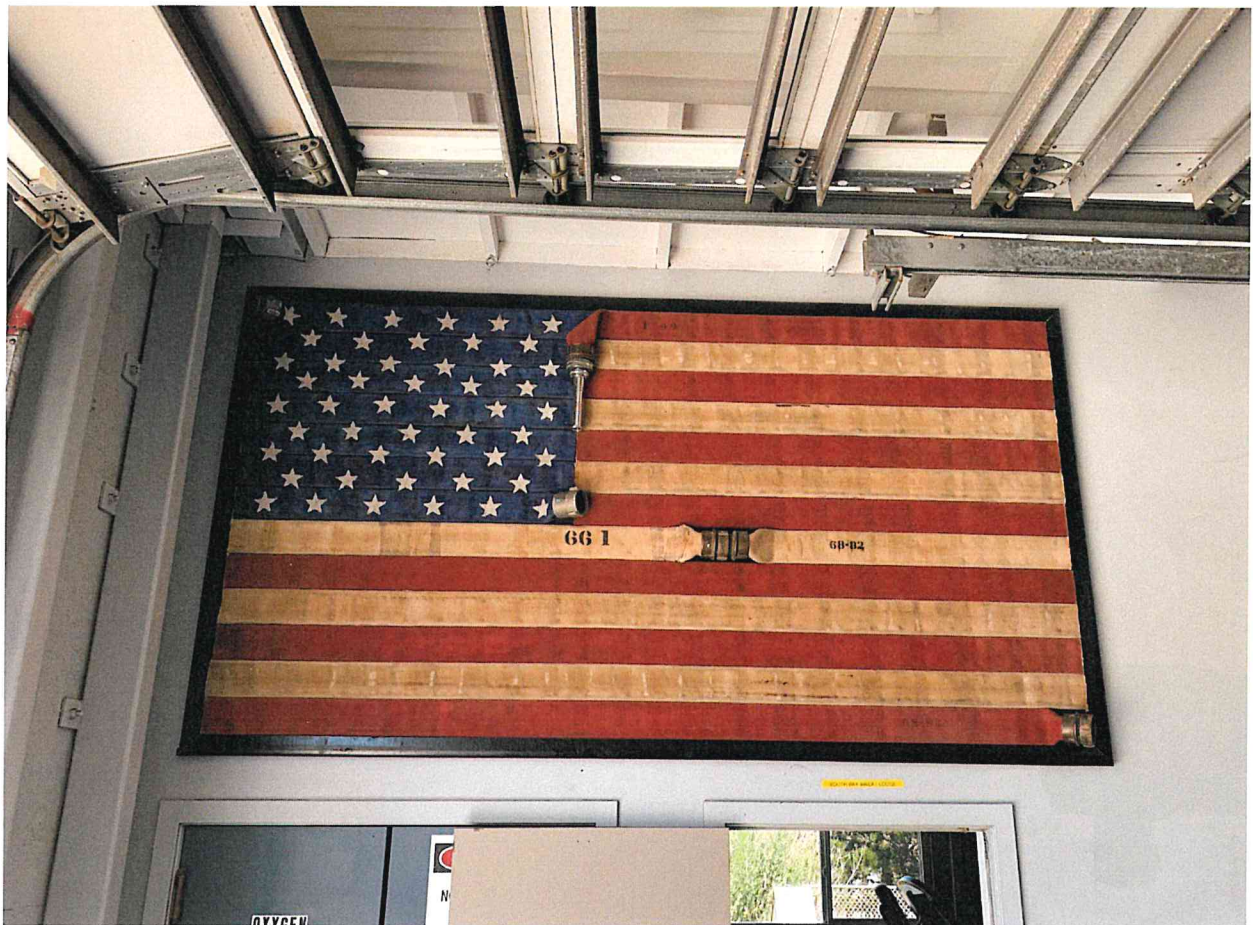
