Summary of the February 11, 2019 Los Osos Fire Safe Focus Group Meeting

The meeting opened at 10:00 a.m. with participant introductions.

The first item was a discussion regarding fire hazards in Monarch Grove. The goal is to reduce fire hazards. The entry permit is still valid. The plan includes removing dead trees and as the butterflies have mostly moved on, there will be no disruption to them.

The Civilian Conservation Corps is cleaning up eucalyptus debris in Montana de Oro.

The SLO County Fire Safe Council has applied for a one million dollar grant that would run from 2019 to 2022.

There will be a meeting on March 30<sup>th</sup> to discuss a Firewise Community Grant for the Cabrillo Estates neighborhood. These grants provide an additional funding source for fire prevention. Los Osos is too big for one grant from this program.

Governor Newsom's new executive orders may be out this winter. He has instructed CAL FIRE to make an assessment to provide additional work regarding fire protection.
