STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Motion: I move that the Board adopt Resolution 2015-27 declaring the 2001 Ford F-150 Utility Vehicle surplus to District needs.

## DISCUSSION

The crew listed the sampling vehicle as needed for replacement in early 2015. They are requesting authorization to sell the old vehicle. In order to do so this vehicle needs to be declared as surplus to District needs. The Utility Vehicle, 2001 Ford F-150 (Unit F) is ready to be added to vehicle surplus. Kelly Blue Book shows the value of this vehicle in fair condition as \$1,511. The truck includes a Workmate camper shell that has an additional value of approximately \$800 - \$1,000. We will provide the vehicle for sale through a public surplus web site and list "as is, where is." This vehicle has been driven hard over the years. Currently the vehicle is inoperable due to the clutch being out of service.

In January 2015 at the Utilities Advisory Committee, staff presented the Mid-Year Budget and requested this vehicle be replaced. The committee recommended the Board accept the staff changes to the Mid-year budget.

At the February 5, 2015 Board meeting, the mid-year adjustments were approved so this vehicle could be replaced.

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## FINANCIAL IMPACT

The financial impact will be an increase in revenue up to approximately \$2,500. Please note that proceeds from sales of this vehicle will be recorded in the Water Fund 500, other revenues. At year-end, proceeds from the sale of this vehicle will be transferred into the Vehicle Replacement Reserve, Water Fund 500, as stated in our Reserves Policy.
