Call to Order, Flag Salute, and Roll Call	Chairperson Tornatzky called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. and led the flag salute.  Roll Call: Alissa Feldman, Committee Member – Absent William Fitzgerald, Committee Member - Present Jennifer Foronjy, Committee Member – Present Andrea Lueker, Committee Member – Absent Shaunna Sullivan, Committee Member – Arrived at 5:40 p.m. Lou Tornatzky, Chairperson – Present  Staff: Renee Osborne, General Manager Ann Kudart, Administrative Services Manager	
2. Approve Parks and Recreation Committee Meeting Minutes of May 1, 2018 and July 3, 2018	Public Comment – Julie Tacker voiced her disappointment that the item regarding removal of the rubber chips would not be at the Board's August 2 <sup>nd</sup> meeting and that it will be another month before it is heard by the Board.  Committee Member Fitzgerald moved to approve the meeting minutes of May 1, 20148 and July 3, 2018. The motion was seconded by Committee Member Foronjy and carried by unanimous consent.	Action: Receive and file the approved minutes.
3. Update Regarding Removal of Recycled Tire Material at Los Osos Community Park	General Manager Osborne reported that volunteers are needed to remove the rubber chips; that Madonna Construction will donate equipment to assist volunteers in loading the rubber chips into the roll-offs; that it is estimated that the driver's time will cost approximately \$2,000 for two 8-hour days; that Mission Country Disposal will donate the majority of the hauling and disposal costs of the rubber chips with the District's cost of \$217 for the roll-off bins; that County permitting will be minimal and require two weeks advance notice to shut down the park; and, that a Safety Inspector will be provided at no cost. She further reported that once commitments from volunteers have been gotten, Board approval will be requested at their September 6th meeting and removal can begin September 22nd, with the new Fibar Chips installed and the project completed by September 27th. The project is estimated to cost \$14,868.  Public Comment – Julie Tacker inquired as to the cost of legal and staff time; that she had written an opinion piece regarding this problem and provided copies to the Committee; that this is a County problem and that Supervisor Gibson has discretionary funds to cover District costs; and, that as the District did not budget for the cost of this project, it must go through the Budget process.  Dan Clancy supported the progression of the project and volunteered his efforts to remove the chips.  Committee Member Foronjy moved that the Committee recommend that the Board approve the project to upgrade the Los Osos Community Park playground to be paid from the Parks and Recreation Reserve Fund in an amount not to exceed \$14,868. The motion was seconded by Committee Member Fitzgerald and carried by unanimous consent.	Action: The Committee recommended that the Board approve the project to upgrade the Los Osos Community Park playground to be paid from the Parks and Recreation Reserve Fund in an amount not to exceed \$14,868.
4.
