EMERGENCY ACTIVITY

1. Station 15 - South Bay responded to 137 calls between January 22, 2022 – February 21, 2022, including 86 Medical Aids, 21 Traffic Collisions; 10 incidents were reported as Fire, 4 as Hazardous; 13 as Public Service Assists; and 3 as False Alarms. Company 15 was called to cover the station or respond to emergencies 2 times between January 22, 2022 – February 21, 2022.
2. Station 15 – On February 19th South Bay Engine Company 15 welcomed the newest member of the Los Osos Community, a healthy baby girl.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS/PROJECTS

3. Station 15 – South Bay final installations of equipment are being completed on Engine 15 and delivery is expected in the next few weeks.
4. Station 15 – South Bay hosted a “Sidewalk CPR” for the community on February 19th at Station 15. Another event will be held later this year in August. Location and times will be announced via social media and the Board report. No need to sign up just show up to the location at the designated time and the crews will walk the student through the process.
