Utilities Department Report for **August 2026**

WATER PRODUCTION INFORMATION

The total production for the month of August 2026 was approximately 15.4 million gallons (MG) with an average daily demand of approximately 502,860 gallons. This represents a 6% increase in production when compared to last year.

Using the State's formula to calculate residential usage of gallons per capita per day (gpcd), for the month of July 2026 our residential customers used 65.3 gpcd, an increase of 7% from 62.4 gallons gpcd in August 2025.

PRODUCTION AND RUNTIME HOURS BY WELL SITE

The following tables break down the production by well site and runtime on the pump motors for the month of August 2026. Totals for last year are included for comparison:

Consumption and revenue data is based on billing for a 60-day period for 57% of the District in this cycle and final bills. Production data is based on a monthly period.

DRAINAGE

The District continues to operate and comply with the General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit for storm water discharges for small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4). The District monitors various drainage systems throughout Los Osos. These facilities include: drainage force mains at 8th & El Moro, 6th & El Moro, Don & Mitchell and 16th & Paso Robles Avenue, drainage basins at Bayridge (on the corner of South Bay Blvd. and Bay Oaks Drive), Tierra Dr., Cabrillo (on Madera St), & Los Arboles retention basin in Vista de Oro. Our crew monitor these drainage facilities on a weekly basis. During rain events they monitor daily. No drainage force mains were operated during the month of August.

Recycled Water

The County delivers recycled water to the Los Osos Middle School. The District is responsible for the maintenance of the recycled water meter and receives the revenue for the monthly consumption.

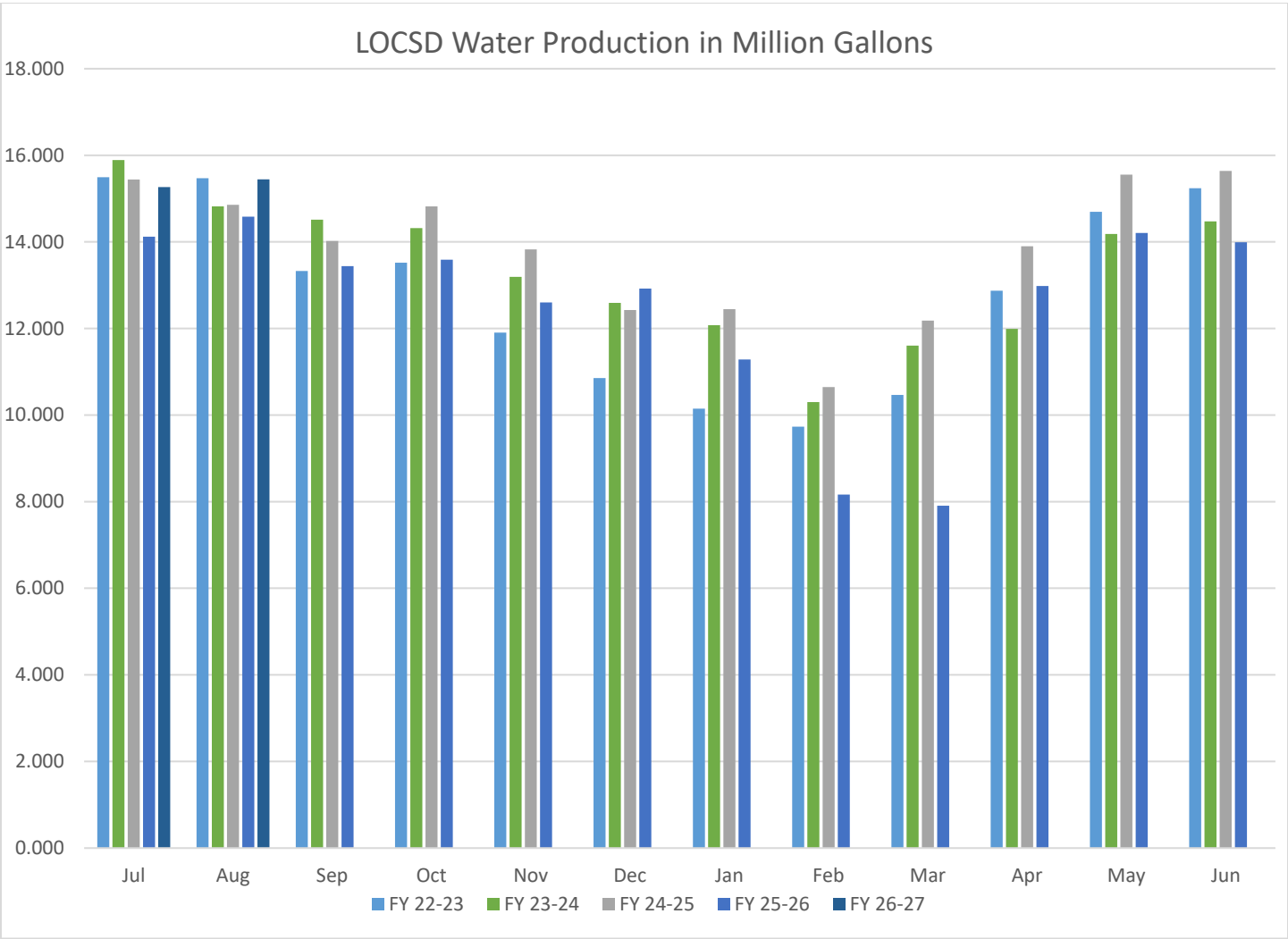
Call-Out Report

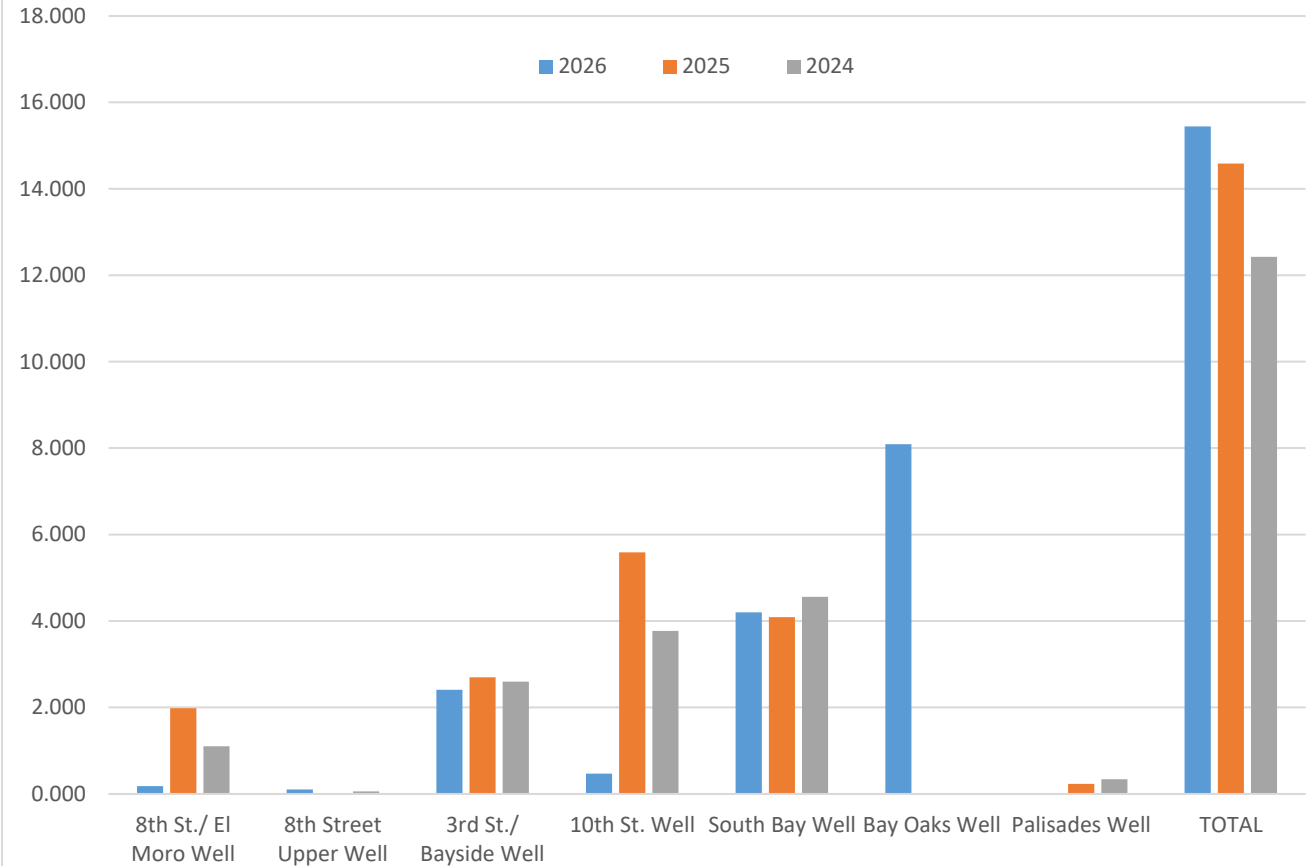

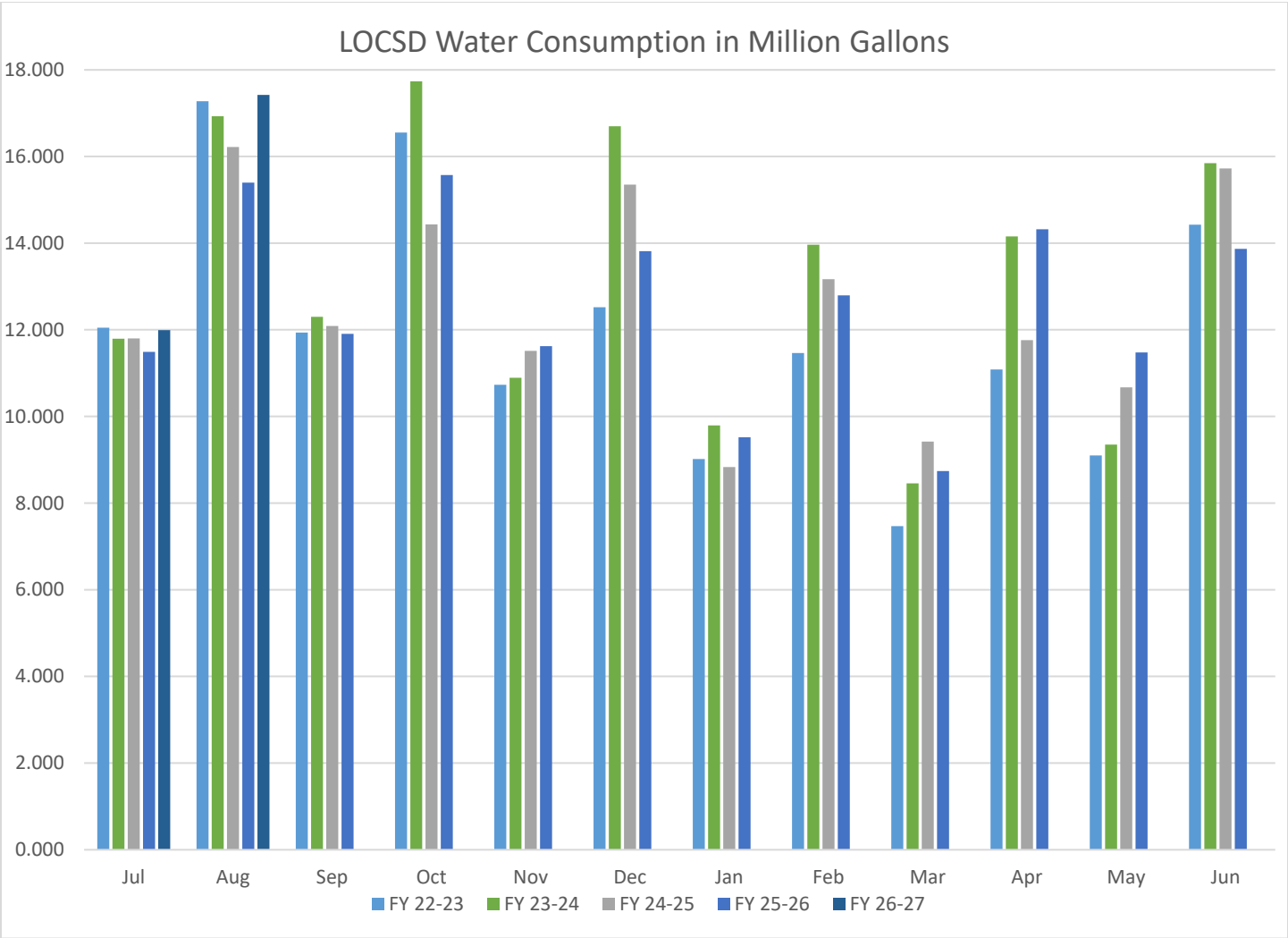
