District /CAL FIRE Chief Report for October 2019**

**EMERGENCY ACTIVITY**

1. Station 15 - South Bay responded to 149 calls between September 25 – October 29th, 2019 including 92 Medical Aids, and 19 Traffic Collisions; 8 incidents were reported as Fire, 6 as Hazardous; 18 as Public Service Assists; and 6 as False Alarms.

Company 15 was called to cover the station or respond to emergencies 5 times between September 25 – October 29th, 2019.

**ADMINISTRATION**

2. On October 10, 2019 Office Technician Carrie Anne Young celebrated her one-year anniversary of working at Station 15 – South Bay.
3. On October 12, 2019 Station 15 – South Bay staff held their Annual Fire Safety Fair. This year's event was held from 11 am – 3 pm in the Rite-Aid Parking Lot and had over five hundred attendees. A big thank you to the Red Cross, Sheriff's Department, Los Osos Fire Safe Council, C.E.R.T. and all our volunteers for making this such a successful event. This year's Fire Safety Fair had a special mission, raising money for a young Los Osos girl who was severely burned when she stepped into a hidden bonfire pit while visiting Montana De Oro State Park with her family in July. Four-year-old Alivia Gonzales suffered severe injuries, she faces a long road to recovery with many financial burdens placed upon her family. The South Bay Fire Department raised over two thousand dollars during the bake sale, silent auction and fill the boot event for the Gonzales family in Alivia's name.
4. On October 15, 2019 Office Technician Carrie Anne Young attended the NPP budget workshop hosted by the County of San Luis Obispo to help educate her on ways budget effectively on our annual NPP reporting.
5. On October 31, 2019 Chris Peterson retired after 40 years in the fire service, 15 of them being here at Station 15 – South Bay. We wish him the best in retirement, he will be greatly missed.

**SPECIAL PROGRAMS/PROJECTS**

6. On October 18, 2019 Station 15 – South Bay Reserve company participated in the 7<sup>th</sup> annual Tough Two event held at the Los Osos Middle School.
7. On October 27, 2019 Station 15 – South Bay participated in the Oktoberfest Event in Baywood where they handed out stickers, gave engine tours, and met with the community.
8. During the month of October Station 15 – South bay continued the hiring process for our new Reserve Firefighters. They are being fitted for uniforms and will complete an in-house academy in December.
