RESOLUTION NO. 2015-06

A RESOLUTION OF THE LOS OSOS COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT AMENDING THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS BYLAWS AND RULES OF DECORUM

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors has reviewed the proposed amendments to the Bylaws and Rules of Decorum, which include modifications to Section 10.3(c) amending the Expense Reimbursement Section regarding Per Diem Allowance.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE ABOVE RECITALS, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE LOS OSOS COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER THAT:

The following Sections are amended to read as follows:
 Bylaws and Rules of Decorum

- 2. MEETINGS
- 2.1 Subject to holiday and scheduling conflicts the regular meeting of the Board of Directors shall be held on the first Thursday of each calendar month <u>at the time and place designated by the Board of Directors at the beginning of each calendar year</u> or if a conflict exists, such other date and/or facilities within the District acceptable to the General Manager.
 - 9. DIRECTOR COMPENSATION
 - 9.4 In no event shall Director's compensation exceed \$200 per day.
- 9.5 <u>Pursuant to Sections 61047 et seq. of the Government Code</u> Director Compensation shall not exceed \$600 in any one calendar month.
 - 11. COMMITTEES assigned alpha coding to all paragraphs 11.1
- b) Subject to the availability of public membership, standing committees shall be comprised of five public voting members and one public alternate, none of whom shall be Directors; and one Director appointed by the President as the non-voting Chairperson and one person appointed by the President as the Vice Chairperson. In the absence of both Chairperson and Vice Chairperson the President may assign a Board Member to temporarily act of the Committee Chairperson in order that the Committee may meet as established by the previously adopted schedule.
- (d) The General Manager shall be an ex-officio member of all standing committees. The Committee Chairperson and Committee Vice Chairperson are non-voting members appointed for the sole purpose of conducting the meeting and shall not provide input into the discussions.
- (e) Voting committee members shall hold office for two years, serving without compensation. <u>Two committee member vacancies occur in the odd numbered years and three committee member vacancies occur in the even numbered years.</u> The alternate committee member shall hold office for a one year term. The District Board of Directors reserves the ability to extend the dates in this paragraph up to 31 days.
- (k) A committee member will automatically be removed if he/she has three unexcused absences or misses <u>four</u> meetings in one calendar year.
 - 12. BOARD MEMBER TRAINING
 - 12.1 Ethics Training (AB1234)
- (a) Pursuant to sections 53234 et seq. of the Government Code all Directors and designated District personnel shall receive at least 2 hours of ethics training every two years.
