

**INSUFFICIENT NOMINEES AND APPOINTMENT OF CANDIDATES- §10515.** If, by 5 p.m. on the 83<sup>rd</sup> day prior to the day fixed for the election, the number of candidates does not exceed the number of seats available for that contest, and if a petition signed by 10 percent of the voters or 50 voters, whichever is the smaller number, requesting that the general district election be held has not been presented to the officer conducting the election, he or she shall submit a certificate of these facts to the supervising authority and request that the supervising authority appoint to the office or offices the person or persons, if any, who have filed declarations of candidacy. The contests for which candidates are appointed pursuant to this code will not be on the ballot.
