




Station 15 Monthly Incident Summary


FIRES BY TYPE




MEDICAL BY TYPE






Station 15 Incidents per Month

- 1. Station 15 San Luis Ambulance has started new service in Los Osos and will be posting an Ambulance in Los Osos from 0900-2100 hours daily as of July 1.
- 2. Station 15 South Bay hired 1 new Reserve Firefighter. Application process remains open
- 3. Station 15 Second round of Vacant Lot inspections will start July 15.
- 4. Station 15 LOCSD met with US Fish and Wildlife Service to discuss weed abatement and habitat conservation methods for Los Osos in the Local Responsibility Areas.
- 5. Station 15 LOCSD met with San Luis Obispo Fire Safe Council to discuss the Los Osos Focus group and potential projects. Fire Safe Council started work on updating the California Wildfire Preparedness Plan for Los Osos las week.






FIRES BY TYPE




MEDICAL BY TYPE






Station 15 Incidents per Month




Station 15 Incidents per Month
