DESCRIPTION R. Michael Wright

> Article 13B of the California Constitution limits the total appropriation funded by proceeds of taxes to amounts adjusted each year by the change in cost of living and the change in population. There are a number of exceptions allowed. One

exception is appropriation for debt service.

I move that the Board adopt Resolution No. 2015-14 establishing Motion: the District's appropriation limit of \$8,510,896 for Fiscal Year 2015/2016.

DISCUSSION

Each year as part of the budget process, the District determines its appropriation limit in accordance with Article 13B of the California Constitution. This is also more commonly known as the Gann Initiative on Spending Limits. The limit is computed using two statistical factors provided by the State Department of Finance. One factor is the change on cost of living using per capita income change for the State. This change is an increase of 3.82%. The second factor is the change in population in the beginning of the calendar year. The District uses the population change in the unincorporated area of San Luis Obispo County which increased by 0.90%. This represents an increase of 1,031 individuals. The appropriation limit of the District for Fiscal Year 2015/2016 increases by 4.5% or \$385,936 over the prior year making the limit to be \$8,510,896. The Fiscal Year 2015/2016 budget shows that only \$2,463,357 qualifies as Proceeds of Taxes subject to the limit. Wastewater Assessments revenue of \$1,146,490 is exempted because it is for Debt Service.

The historical trend of the District's appropriation limits since the inception of the District is attached as Exhibit A. Other pertinent information is reflected in Attachments B and C.

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RESOLUTION 2015-14

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE LOS OSOS COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT ADOPTING THE FISCAL YEAR 2015/2016 LOCSD "GANN" APPROPRIATIONS LIMIT

WHEREAS, Article XIIIB of the California Constitution Prohibits governmental agencies from appropriating proceeds of taxation in excess of their appropriations limit for that year:

WHEREAS, the Ballot Measure forming the Los Osos Community Services District (LOCSD) prescribed that the historical base for LOCSD's appropriations limit would be the last appropriations limit adopted by the County of San Luis Obispo for CSA9 and said limit was \$4,259,330 for FY98-99;

WHEREAS, based on statistics published by the State Department of Finance showing the change in Per Capita Cost of Living as 3.82% and Change in Population in the unincorporated area of the County as 0.90% for the most recent calendar year, the appropriation limit for the Los Osos Community Services District has been determined to increase by a factor of 1.0475.

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the application of the factor over the preceding year's appropriation limit results in an appropriation limit for the District of \$8,510,896 for the budget year 2015-2016.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE LOS OSOS COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE, AND DETERMINE:

1. That the appropriation limit for Fiscal Year 2015-2016 for the District is \$8,510,896;
