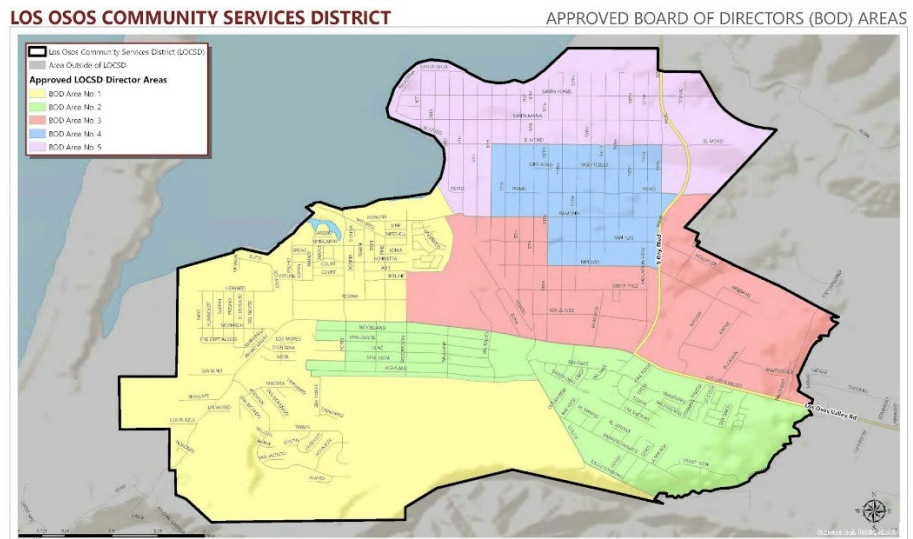

Filing Period Open for Board of Directors Election

The District recently published the official Notice of Election for the upcoming Board of Directors election. Prospective candidates interested in serving on the Board may file nomination papers for the three anticipated vacancies representing Director Areas 1, 2, and 4. Each position carries a four-year term.

The nomination period opens Monday, July 13, 2026, and closes at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, August 7, 2026. Interested candidates should contact the San Luis Obispo County Elections Division at (805) 781-5228 to schedule an appointment to obtain nomination papers. If an incumbent does not file by the deadline, the nomination period will be extended through Wednesday, August 12, 2026, for non-incumbent candidates. If there are insufficient candidates and no petition for an election is filed, appointments may be made pursuant to Elections Code Section 10515.



Passage of Measure B-26

The County has now published official final results for the June 2nd election that Measure B-26 passed with 3,465 for, 2,943 against, and 313 non-votes. This is an important step in completing the negotiations with San Luis Coastal Unified School District (SLCUSD) and moving forward with the final steps to acquire the Sunnyside School property. The District will now start working on finalizing an agreement with the school district and move towards implementing a

comprehensive master planning effort to ensure we receive public input on what amenities and programs the community envisions.

Emergency Services Advisory Committee Vacancy

The District is accepting applications to fill one vacancy on the Emergency Services Advisory Committee following a member's resignation. Applications may be submitted to the District office and will be accepted until the vacancy is filled. Board Director Tom Cross, as the appointing Board member, will make the appointment and may appoint any qualified individual, regardless of whether an application has been submitted.
