EMERGENCY ACTIVITY

1. Station 15 - South Bay responded to CPR call in the Cuesta by the Sea area. After 20 minutes of CPR patient regained pulses and was transported to the hospital and is recovering.

2. Starion 15 – South Bay responded reported structure fire in the area of 10th and Santa Ynez. Upon arrival the building was charged with smoke. After further investigation a small fire to the rear of Kuma restaurant was found and extinguished. Businesses suffered minor damage from smoke and suppression efforts, no injuries occurred.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS/PROJECTS

- 1. Station 15 South Bay met with the Consultants performing the assessment of the Fire Station and reviewed the options presented.
- 2. Station 15 South Bay conducted multi company drill with San Luis Obispo County Fire and Morro Bay Fire Department on structure fire operations.
- 3. Station 15 South Bay met with County Emergency Medical Services and San Luis Ambulance to discuss response times to Los Osos and how to improve them.
- 4. Station 15 Weed abatement inspections will commence May 1st.
- 5. Station 15 Entered into a service agreement for 3rd party hose testing.
- 6. CAL FIRE San Luis Obispo 4291 Defensible Space Inspections have started and the inspectors will be in the Los Osos area within the next month.
